

DOTTED QUARTER NOTES

If a dot is placed after a note, the note's value is increased by one half.

Dotted whole note
 $4 + 2 = 6$

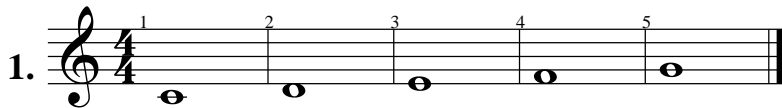
Dotted half note
 $2 + 1 = 3$

Dotted quarter note
 $1 + 1/2 = 1 \frac{1}{2}$

The rhythm that we will be studying in this chapter will be the dotted quarter-eighth pattern.

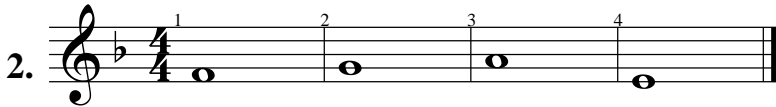


ECHOES ONE



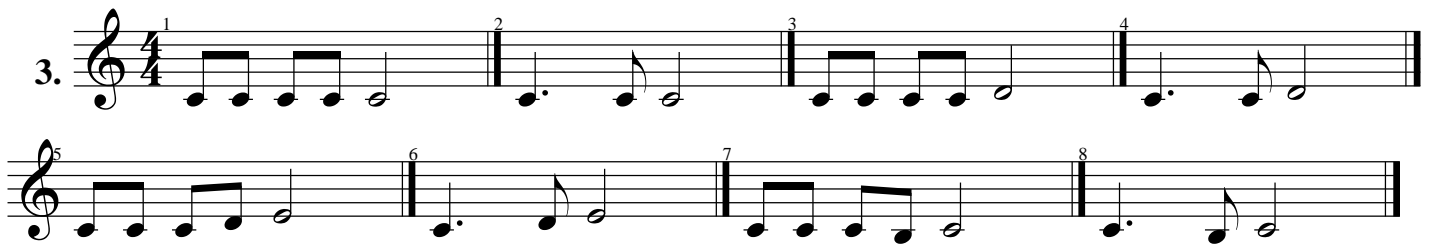
Your teacher will play some one or two measure echoes using these notes. Listen closely and echo back.

ECHOES TWO

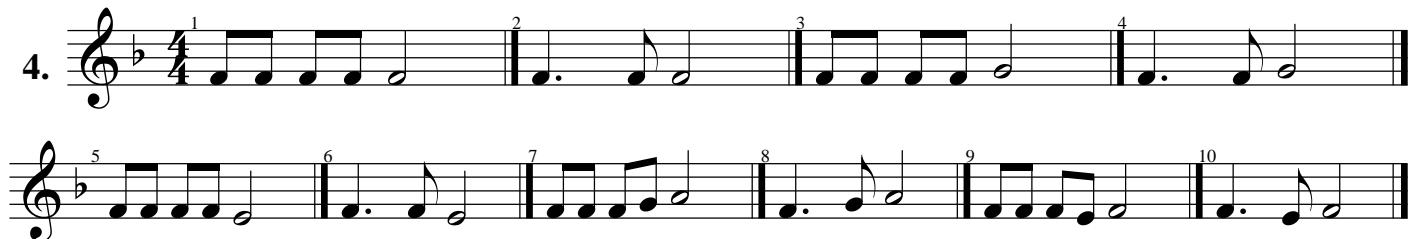


In these next two exercises your teacher will play a measure then the class will echo the measure. When the class is ready, each member of the class can take turns being the leader.
