chromatic----moving up or down by half-steps


accidental ---- a musical sign (flat, sharp, natural) that changes the key signature.
*a musical rule---- once an accidental is placed in a measure it will be in effect for th rest of that measure.

enharmonic---a note that has two different names (example--F# and G b)

sharp (#) a sign that raises the pitch one half step



<u>flat</u> (b) a sign that lowers the pitch one half step **<u>natural</u>** (c) no flat or sharp affects the note
